Come explore the sites of flowers in bloom in Holland/Amsterdam on a bike and barge excursion. You will depart Pensacola on Delta Airlines April 27th and arrive in Amsterdam the following morning and board our ship Sarah. Sail right through the center of the city and take a short cycle trip following the banks of the river Amstel ending in Uithoorn/Kudelstaart. The barge will follow you and meet you at the end of the cycle tour each day. Some of the sights you will see are: Langeraarse Plassen; Brassemer Meer; Leiden-Rembrandt's birthplace; seaside resort Katwijk; Zandvoort; Haarlem; Spaarndam-the village of Hans Brinker; Nauerna; Zaanse Schans; Alkmaar-cheese town; Bergen and Schoorl; Hondsbossche Zeewering-seawall; Hoorn; Schermerhorn-windmill museum; Purmerend; Edam; Volendam-fishing village; and many more sights. If you don't want to bike you can tour on your own the areas we visit.

ACCOMMODATIONS: Ship Sarah...this ship started to sail with passengers in 2002. This modern ship is spacious and furnished in a tasteful way. The living area has a comfortable sitting corner and a small bar. All cabins have level beds (no bunks) and private facilities. On deck, one will find several nice sitting areas and enough space for sun bathing. The ship is equipped with:
